



To promote and encourage increased investment in ICT Infrastructure in order to develop a digital-based economy for Akwa Ibom State.





To deliver effective, efficient and comprehensive healthcare services to all citizens.




To increase investments in public health facilities and infrastructure to meet the growing demand for healthcare services in the post-covid era.

#### SELECTED STRATEGIES

#### **AGRICULTURE**

- Develop full value-chains for the major crops in the State using farm settlement schemes.
- Promote access to Agricultural Credit Facilities through Ibom FADAMA Microfinance Bank and other agricultural credit banks.
- Encourage the participation of women and youths in agribusiness
- Provide adequate technical support including extension services and capacity building through a revamped Akwa Ibom Agricultural Development Programme (AKADEP).
- Establish a College of Agriculture
- Stimulate the economy of the coastal communities by providing fishing trawlers and fish processing plants









### SELECTED STRATEGIES

#### **HEALTH**

- Revitalise Primary Health Care Centres
- Set up a Senior Citizens Health Scheme
- Revive and upgrade existing primary healthcare centres across the State.
- Establish a Medical City and incorporate the aspect of Wellness and Health Spas, leveraging on our serene and scenic environment, wonderful cuisine and natural remedies.
- Set up a State Health Insurance Scheme
- Reassess the free maternal, newborn and child health care services to the less privileged and vulnerable people in the State to make it more sustainable.





SELECTED STRATEGIES



- Build state-of-the-art primary and secondary schools in each of the ten (10) federal constituencies.
- Prioritise Training and Retraining of Teachers to enhance their productivity
- Embark on an extensive renovation of dilapidated school buildings and related infrastructure.
- Establish and expand technical and vocational training centres
- Reassess the free and compulsory education policy with a view to making it more functional
- Promote student Scholarship Schemes to qualified Akwa Ibom students in Nigerian public tertiary institutions.

#### **INFRASTRUCTURE**

- Consolidation and implementation of Ibom Deepsea Port project
- Provide potable water across the state
- Provide rural communities with electricity and good road network
- Develop a road masterplan
- Restore Ibom Power to its original 191MW with an additional 114MW turbine
- Expand the scope of the statewide mass metering programme
- Ensure effective utilization of the 21 storey office complex

#### **WOMEN EMPOWERMENT**

- Embark on massive skills acquisition and training programmes for women across diverse sectors of the economy
- Promote the training and retraining of women in vocational and technical educational programmes.
- Assist women in business start-ups and entrepreneurial ventures through mentorship initiatives with already established entrepreneurs
- Encourage qualified women to vie for elective positions in their communities and state

SELECTED STRATEGIES

#### TRANSPORTATION

- Review the entire transport network in the State with a view to upgrading for efficiency and effectiveness in service delivery
- Provide an effective township taxi scheme
- Develop a comprehensive transport database in the State
- Set up a transport stakeholders forum for effective interface with government to regulate the sector.
- Establish a Transport Management Agency to help in traffic management and control
- Implement an Integrated Transport System
- Consolidate Ibom Air as the leading airline in Nigeria and establish footprints in the West and Central African sub-Region

### **COMMERCE, TRADE AND INDUSTRY**

- Promote the use of Made-in-Akwa Ibom products and services.
- Establish Business Hubs across the state in various sectors including Fashion, Carpentry, Shoemaking, etc
- Encourage the formation of Cooperatives amongst MSMEs
- Create an Industrial Park
- Establish an International Market to curb capital flight
- Promote and support the establishment of industrial layouts and clusters





#### SELECTED STRATEGIES

#### **OIL & GAS**

- Domestication of the Nigerian Local Content Law
- Facilitate the creation of Job opportunities through collaborative efforts with operating and oil servicing companies in the State
- Promote and support citizens to engage in Oil & Gas activities
- Promote long term investments in the education and training of indigenous highlyskilled manpower in the Oil and Gas sector
- Ensure the use of sustainable and environment-friendly practices in value chains in the Oil and Gas sector

- Enact appropriate mining/land use laws for environmental and mineral resources sustainability and revenue generation
- Map out the locations of industrial Minerals that abound in the State to support investment in exploration and mining development

- Facilitate and promote investments in Minerals mining infrastructure in the State
- Ensure the use of sustainable and environment-friendly practices in exploration and mining.

- Promote the establishment and support of cottage industries in the rural areas

- Partner with the private sector to fast-track tourism development in the state
- Launch a deliberate destination marketing campaign with clear-cut key performance indicators (KPIs)
- Establish an International Hotel and Tourism Institute to raise the standard of hotel services in the State
- Provide grants and support for the creative and entertainment industry in the State
- Revive the state's art and cultural centre
- Set up special skills support programme to rekindle interest in fine and creative arts

- Develop and implement Security and safety Sector structure
- Collaborate and liaise with the local communities on security and safety issues
- Invest in modern security infrastructure for improved security management
- Liaise with various security agencies to sustain peace in the state

- Increase security presence in conflict-prone and securitychallenged communities including land and sea entry points






SELECTED STRATEGIES
